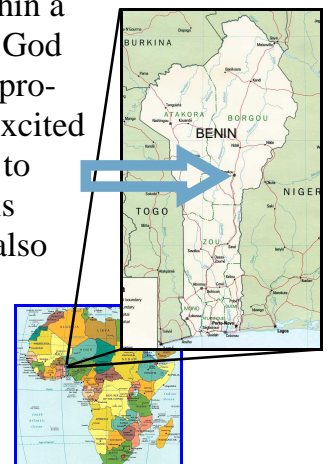

Less than four months until the departure date for French language school and then relocating to Benin, West Africa

Soon after our August newsletter was sent we received a contract on our home. Homes are selling very slowly in the Dallas area so we were a bit surprised and reminded that God's timing is always perfect when we had a contract after only 3 weeks. We quickly built a storage building at Donna's parent's farm in Gainesville, TX (1 1/2 hours north of Dallas). We then sorted and packed up our belongings with the help of Paul's mom from New Mexico, and moved to the farm. Paul commutes to Dallas each week and spends two nights with Donna's sister Joy and her family. Donna was able to finish two work projects the week after moving and is now only teaching an online course, which requires minimal trips to Dallas. The kids have adjusted easily to life on the farm. They are enjoying the local country school and taking care of all of the farm animals though the greatest part is being with Grandma and Grandpa Johns everyday.

Paul will be in Benin, West Africa November 1 through November 17 to help build a broadcast tower. This tower will be the main broadcast tower we will be working with once we arrive in Benin. This is such an awesome opportunity and nothing short of a miracle. In order for Paul to go, all of his professors had to grant him permission to miss classes and Paul had to find a ticket within a certain budget. Once again God opened all of the doors and provided a way. We are very excited for the opportunity for Paul to be on the groundwork of this new project. This trip will also give Paul an opportunity to meet with coworkers and to finalize some of the details for our upcoming move to Benin. This trip does put a bit more pressure on Paul in finishing his thesis and his classes, though by God's grace it will all fall into place.

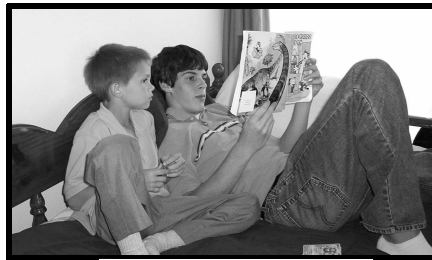

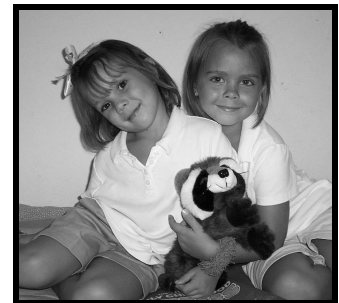
