2011 Year in Review

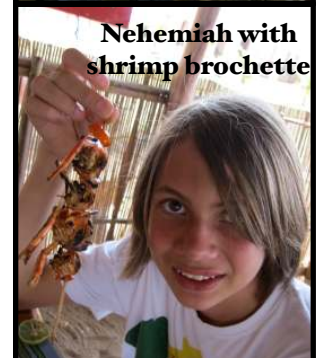
- ~ Miriam joins siblings at RVA, missionary boarding school in Kenya
